Superior Units (Peace and Joy):

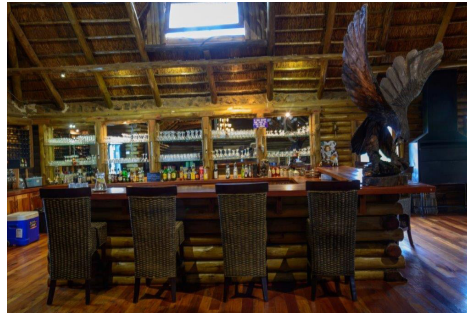
At R1350.00 per couple per night, these units offer luxurious amenities, including a Four Poster Bed, a spacious bath, and elegant furnishings.
