DAY 1

Friday - 7 August 2026

Arrival - Johannesburg > SunEden

We will meet you at O.R. Tambo International Airport and transfer you to your accommodation at SunEden Naturist Resort. Meals will be served depending on arrival times.

Saturday - 8 August 2026

Zebra Safaris

DAY 8

Friday - 14 August 2026

Travel -- Johannesburg > Cape Town

Enjoy a hearty breakfast at SunEden before traveling to O.R. Tambo for the flight to Cape Town. Light lunch and Dinner in Cape Town. Meals dependant on flight times.

DAY 12

Tuesday - 18 August 2026

V & A Waterfront & Robben Island

DAY 10

Sunday - 16 August 2026

Boulders Penguins

Visit the famous African Penguins at Boulders Beach, breakfast en route, before continuing on to Cape Point, where dramatic cliffs and sweeping ocean views showcase the wild beauty of the Cape Peninsula. Light lunch en route and dinner in Cape Town.

DAY 14

Thursday - 20 August 2026

Table Mountain

Take the cableway up Table Mountain for panoramic views over Cape Town, the coastline, and surrounding peaks, with breakfast en route. Continue to the colourful Bo-Kaap, known for its vibrant houses and rich Cape Malay heritage, light lunch en route, ending the day with dinner in Cape Town.

DAY 11

Monday - 17 August 2026

Spice Route

Enjoy a visit to the Spice Route for wine, beer, gin, and chocolate tastings, breakfast en route, followed by a relaxed light lunch in the heart of Franschhoek. Dinner in Cape Town

DAY 15

Friday - 21 August 2026

Departure - Cape Town

After breakfast, transfer to Cape Town International Airport. Meals dependant on flight times.
