The Big5 Safari Naturist Group Tour takes our guests to 3 parks - the Dinokeng Game Reserve, the Pilanesberg Game Reserve and to the Kruger National Park. The one Leopard had a "kill" (Impala) in the tree which he was having for dinner. We had not seen that before. We can honestly say that this group had a lot of luck regarding sightings. Amanda often says that for every 1 wild animal which we see on a safari, another 10 see us but we often don't see them, especially the wild cats like Lions, Leopards and Cheetahs. We honestly believe that guests who have a positive mindset, they do see a lot more animals.

We can never rely on the driver/guide to see all the animals when he is also looking at the road and looking for animal tracks. We always need our guests to look for animals. On that January 2026 tour, our guests saw more animals than normal and that was because of their positive attitude. Apart from the safaris, our guests also went on the following excursions: Lesedi Cultural Village, the Chameleon Market, Maropeng Cradle of Humankind, Sterkfontein Caves, Harties Cableway and the Lion and Cheetah Sanctuary. One of the highlights was the time spent at Marloth Park, where we had the following visitors who popped around at the houses: Kudus, Impalas, Warthogs, Bush Buck and a Mongoose family. We also saw Giraffes and Zebras walking in the Marloth Park

village and we saw Bush Babies in the one restaurant outdoor area.

All 12 of our guests on that tour came from the same naturist resort in the USA, so they knew each other. They played a card game which we had never seen before. They had a lot of fun and laughter.
